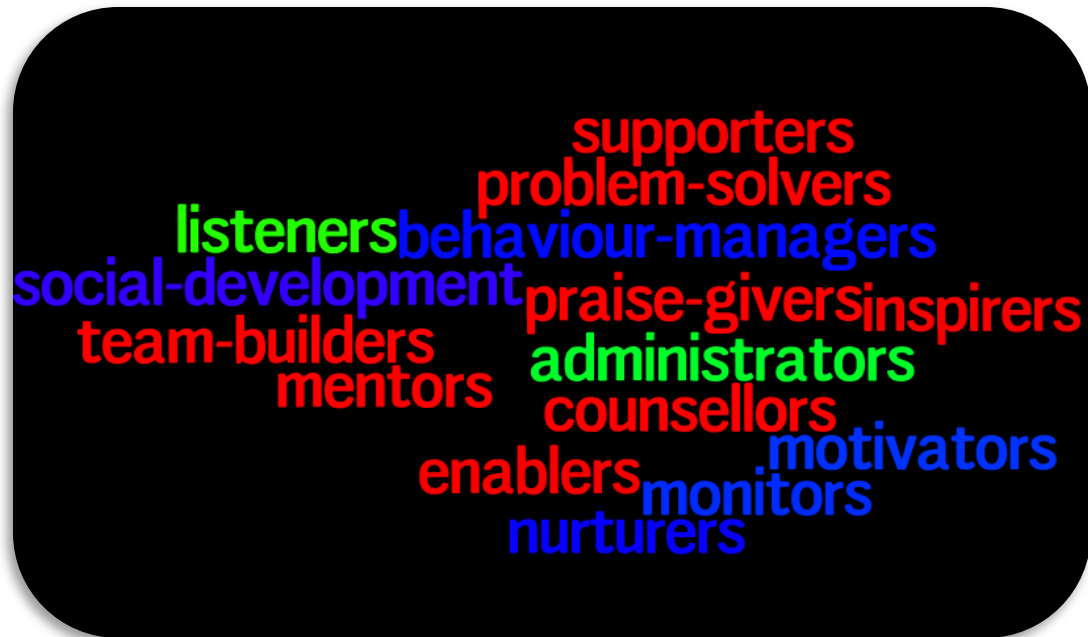

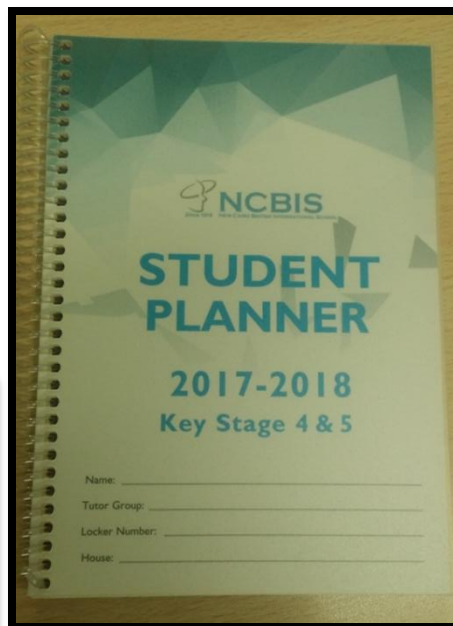

Student Planners:

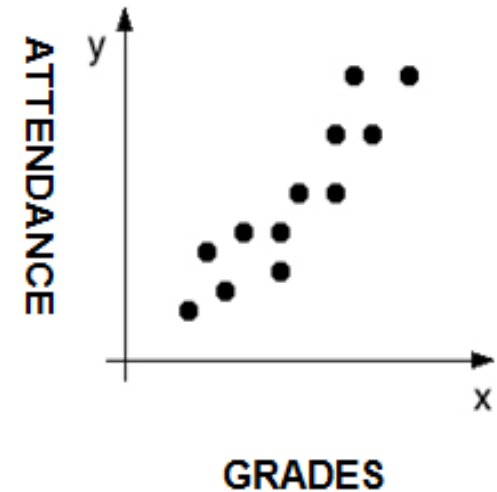
- Contains useful information for parents as well as students

Homework:

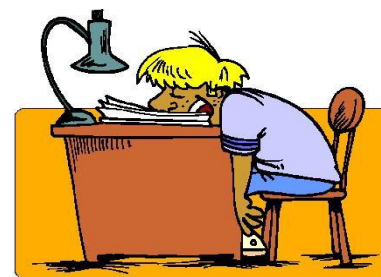
Year 10 & 11

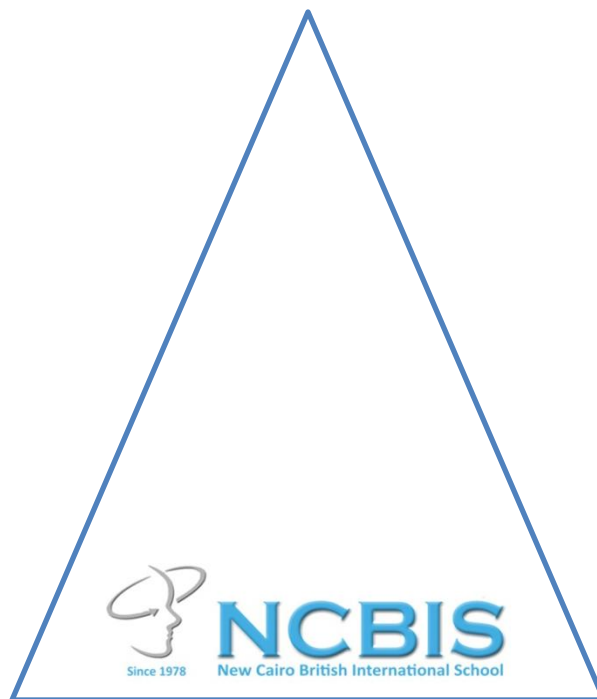
